

Trestle Bike Park Event Update – Lift & Trail Impacts and Closures MOUNTAIN STATES CUP –SEPTEMBER 3-6, 2010

Friday –

No impact on trails or lifts. Athletes will be inspecting courses but no closures planned.

Saturday –

No lift impact.

Limited Trail impact - Green World will be closed from bottom of Free Speech to Tunnel Hill (including Upper Cherokee to Tunnel Hill) and the very lowest section from Serenity intersection to the road to nowhere until the conclusion of the Cross Country Races.

Watch for Marshals coming off of No Quarter heading to Long Trail as racers will be crossing the bottom of No Quarter and Long Trail to get to 4-Points.

Sorensen Dual Slalom course will be for closed all day for racing.

Sunday –

Lift Impacts - Alternating racer lift line will be in effect all day. Please be courteous and alternate in groups of 3.

Trail Impacts – Shy Ann will be closed for the race until noon, then open the remained of the day. Trestle Downhill, Lower Boulevard, and Bear Arms will be closed until the conclusion of Downhill Training at 4pm. Upper Boulevard will be open but use caution as you exit Pipe Cut above 5-Points.

Road to Nowhere, Turnpike, and Lower Green World from the top of Sorensen down will be used for Short Track Cross Country until 2pm.

Monday –

Lift Impacts - Alternating racer lift line will be in effect until the conclusion of the downhill race. Please be courteous and alternate in groups of 3.

Trail Impacts –Trestle Downhill, Lower Boulevard, and Bear Arms will be closed until the conclusion of Downhill race ~ 3pm. Upper Boulevard will be open but use caution as you exit Pipe Cut above 5-Points.
